2010-11 DECLARATION OF HOME-BASED INSTRUCTION

A parent who intends to cause his/her child or children to receive home-based instruction in lieu of attendance or enrollment in a public school, approved private school or an extension program of an approved private school, must file an annual declaration of intent to do so in the format prescribed below:

I do hereby declare that I am the parent, guardian, or legal custodian of the child(ren) listed below; and that said child(ren) is (are) between the ages of eight and eighteen and as such are subject to the requirements found in Chapter 28A.225, Compulsory Attendance; I intend to cause said child(ren) to receive home-based instruction as specified in 28A.225.010(4); and if a certified person will be supervising the instruction, I have indicated this by checking the appropriate space.
