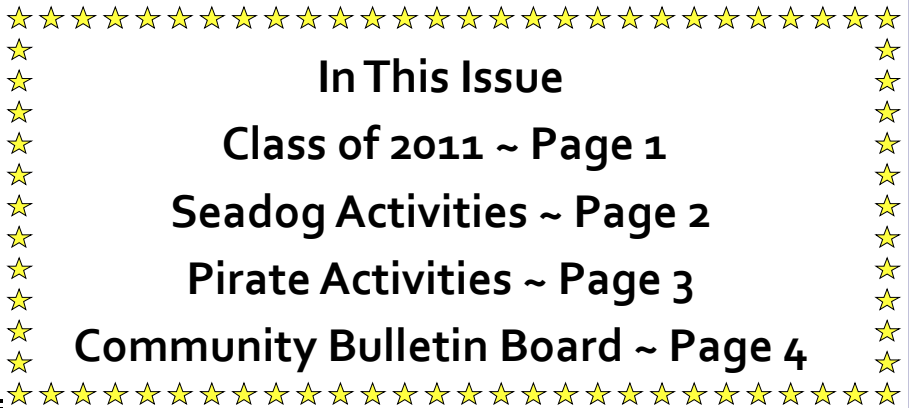
Support Adna Seniors
