## Changes to Benefit School to Family Communications

The Adna School District is excited about its recent conversion to Skyward Family Access. Skyward is a web-based student information database that allows parents and students to view grades, attendance, and GPA history. The new system will enhance Parent/Teacher communications. Soon Family Access will also have an online web store. Within the web store, you will be able to use your credit/debit card securely to make lunch payments, purchase ASB cards, pay Athletic/Activity Fee's, yearbooks, fees & fines, all of which are instantly applied to your students' account. Simply look for the Family Access link under "Quick Links" on the district's website. Should you have any questions, please contact your child's school office.

## Back to school Reminders

**Registration:** New students may register at the AES school office from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.. All new students should register as soon as possible. Full day kindergarten is \$75.00 per month for ten months or \$750.00 for the year. Those that qualify for free or reduced lunch will also qualify for reduced kindergarten tuition. Please contact the District Office at 360-748-0362.

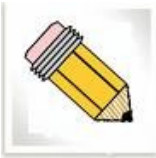

## ADNA MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL REMINDERS AND INFORMATION



⇒ **Registration:** New students are requested to contact the office to set up an appointment. Returning students' schedules will be mailed out before school begins.

⇒ **School Supplies:** Middle school lists are available on the schools website ([www.adnaschools.org](http://www.adnaschools.org)) or at the AMHS office. All students need to come prepared with; paper, binders, pens, pencils, etc. on the first day of school.

⇒ **ASB Cards:** The cost is \$30.00 per student or \$60.00 for families with three or more students in grades 6-12. Cards must be a single purchase to be eligible for the discounted price. Students qualifying for free lunch, ASB price is waived. Students qualifying for Reduced lunch, ASB price \$15.00. In order to qualify, a 2010/11 Free & Reduced application must be approved prior to the ASB card being purchased - - No Refunds. Middle and high school students with an ASB card receive free admission to home games and reduced admission at away games. Students are required to have a current ASB card to participate in extracurricular and incentive programs.

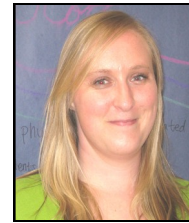


⇒ **Physical:** Middle/High school students planning to participate in school sponsored sports are required to have a current physical on record prior to turning out: necessary forms are in the school office.

⇒ **Athletics:** Students turning out for fall sports must clear the following through the school office: *current physical, medical waiver, proof of medical insurance (if a family does not have insurance coverage, policies can be purchased through the school office. Rates may vary depending on the policy selected), signed activity code of conduct, current ASB card, paid the individual "Pay to Participate" fee for extracurricular activities (\$25.00 for middle school participants and \$40.00 for high school participants per sport).*

Season and yearly sports passes for both adult and Senior Citizen's are also available for purchase to all games in the AMHS office or at home games.
